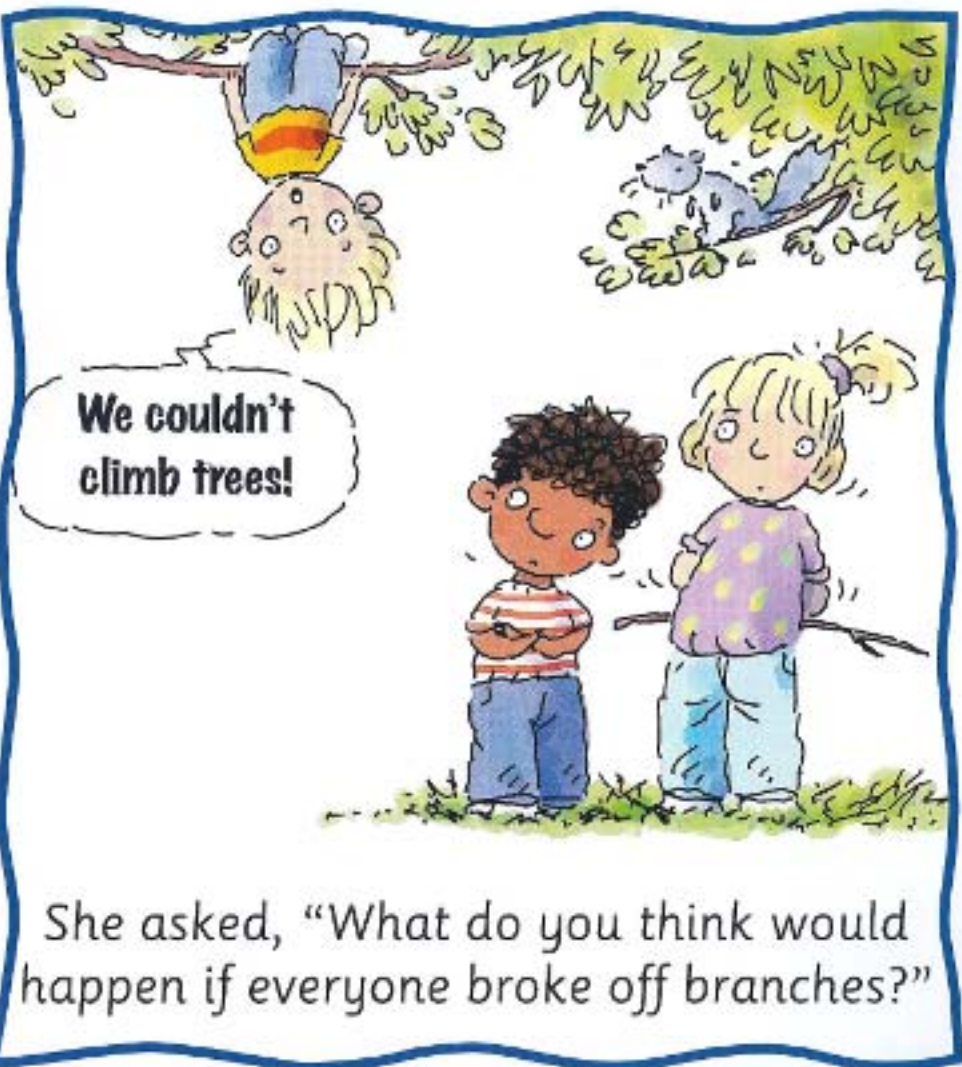


Our teacher, Miss Wade, said we should protect nature, not hurt it.

Why should I protect nature?



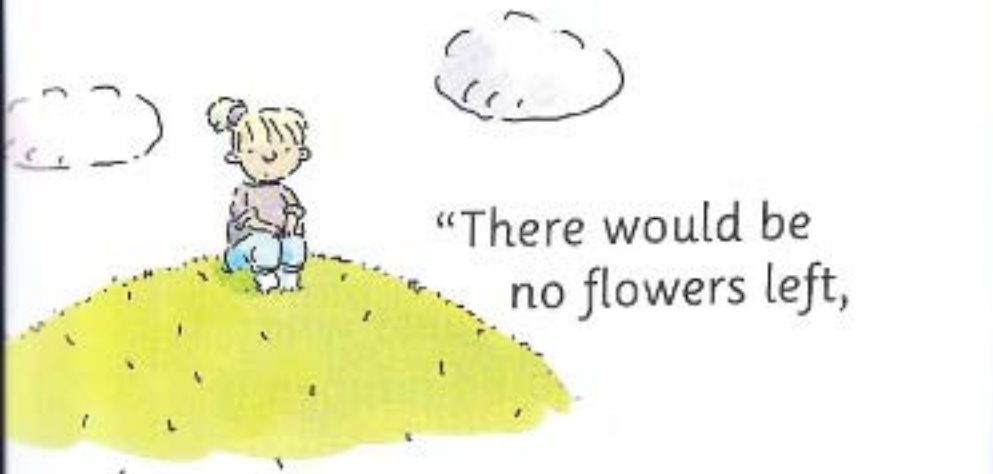
She asked, "What do you think would happen if everyone broke off branches?"

“The trees would have no leaves left, and they couldn’t grow properly. Birds couldn’t nest in their branches.



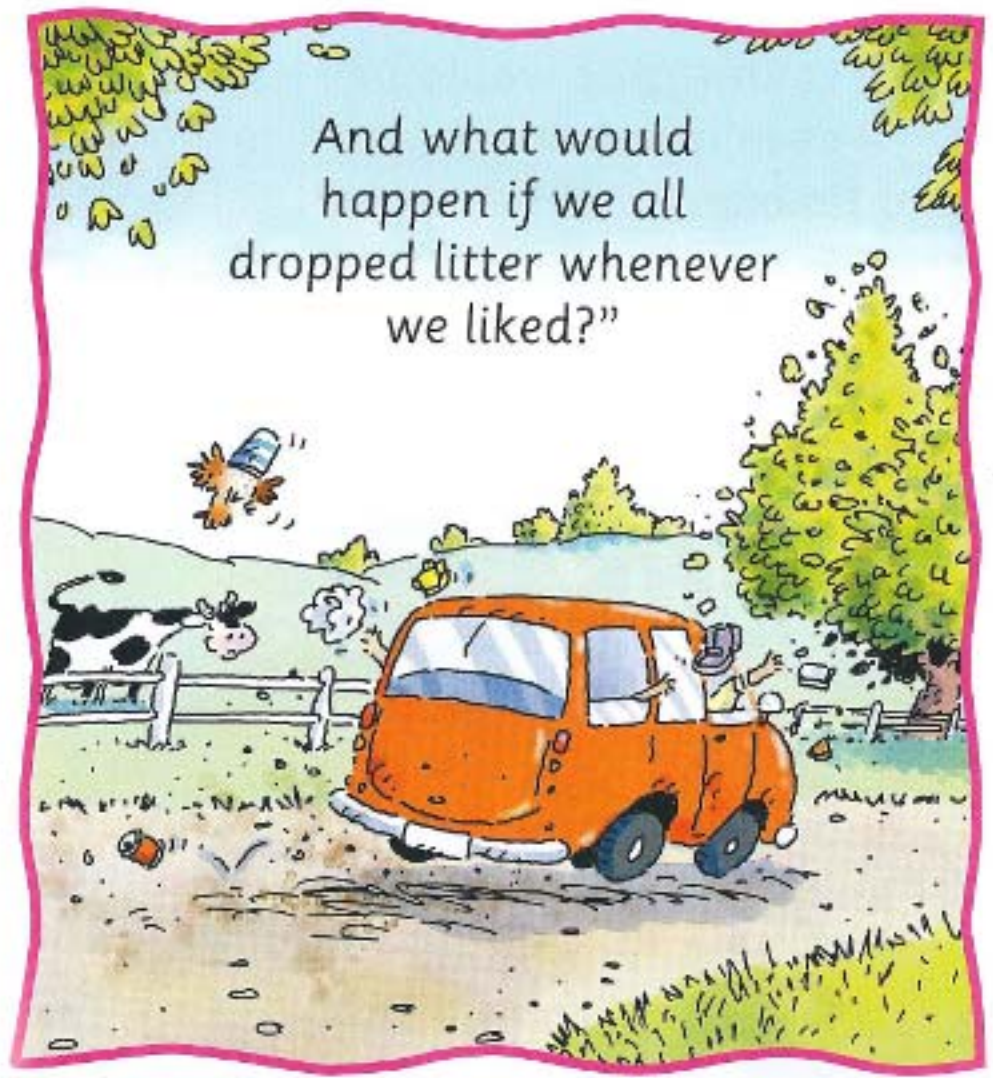
And guess what would happen if we all picked flowers and swatted bees?”





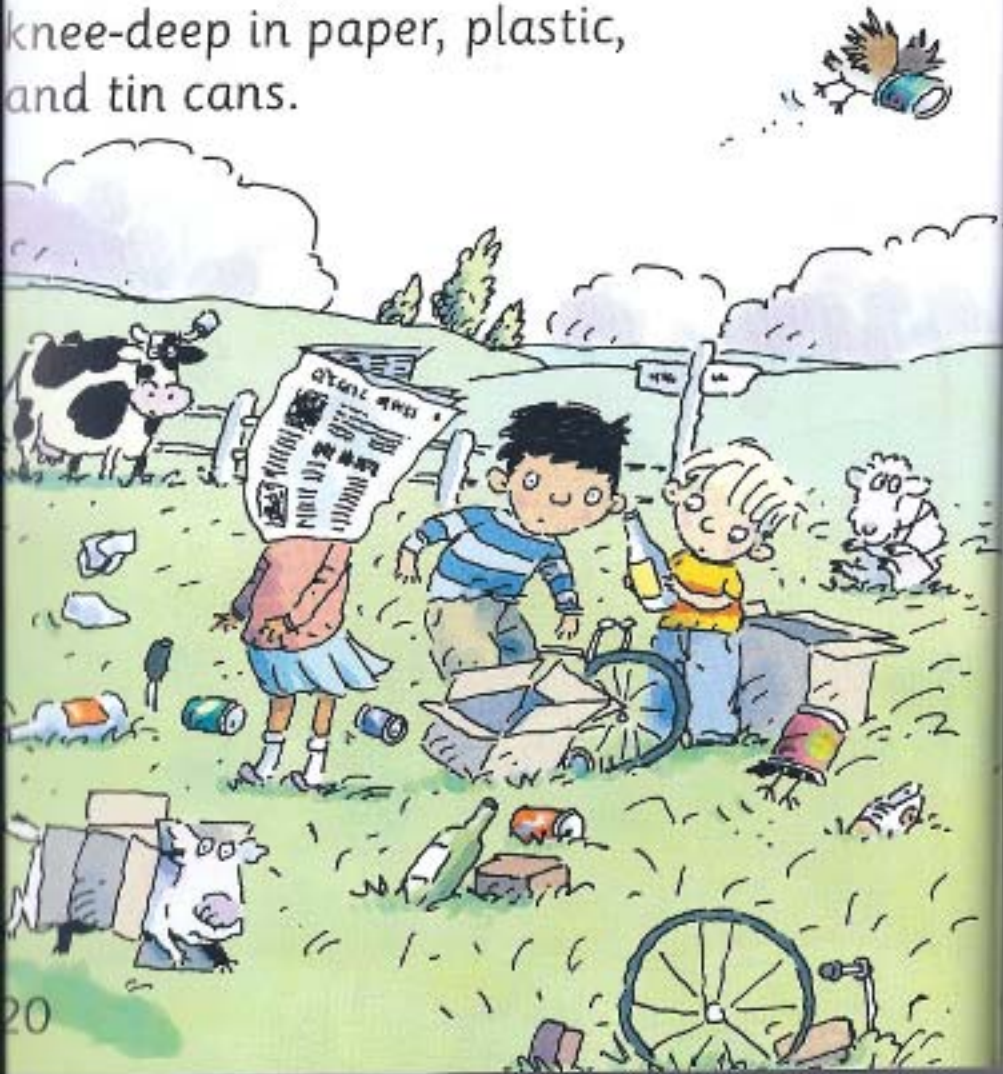
“There would be

we liked?”

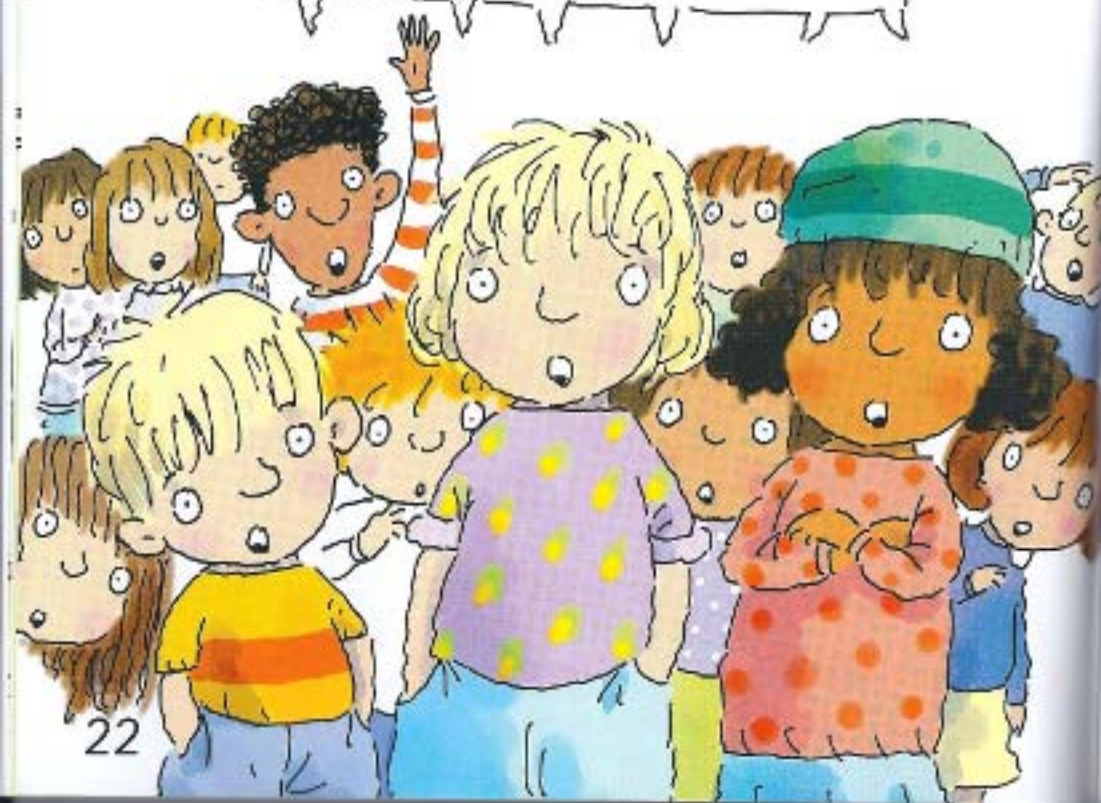
"The countryside would be knee-deep in paper, plastic, and tin cans.
